Main Replacement Works - Gooloogong

Council and contractors have commenced works on a new water main to Gooloogong under the Forbes Road. These works are part of the overall replacement of the water main line into Gooloogong.

Works are anticipated to take 10 days (weather permitting) with access to private residences/properties being maintained wherever possible during works.

Parking will be restricted on a small portion of Forbes Road to enable these works. Residents and motorists are also advised that there may be minor disruptions and changes to traffic conditions during this time. Council will have traffic control measures in place during the work and all temporary signage and traffic control measures should be followed.

Interruptions to the water supply will be required at a later stage of the Project. Council will give sufficient notice prior to any instance where the water is to be turned off.
