Cowra Open Space Legacy Public Art Mural Project

Cowra Council has been successful in receiving grant funding under the NSW Public Spaces Legacy Program to commission a number of public art mural projects in the Cowra Shire Local Government Area.

Submissions to the Expression of Interest (EOI) are now invited to undertake one (or all) of the public art installations that are being proposed as part of this exciting project. Shared Pathway Project Lachlan River Precinct

Works will soon commence to construct the second stage of the River Park shared pathway. The second stage begins at the Cowra Aquatic Centre and will provide a route around Twigg Oval to Carobean Avenue to the west. The section of path will be approximately 300m in length.

These works stem from the concept plan of the Lachlan River Precinct Master Plan prepared by Cowra Council in consultation with the community. Works include acknowledgement of the traditional custodians of the river area with animal depictions along paths and plantings of culturally important plant species. Funding for the work has been provided by the NSW Government through the Public Spaces Legacy Program.

The third and final stage of the shared pathway will be constructed after the new water pipeline from Billimari has been installed along Carobean Avenue. Stage 3 of the shared pathway will then link stages 1 and 2, providing approximately 630m of new shared pathway and three riverside picnic areas in the Lachlan River Precinct.
