

George Campbell Bridge Replacement Update

Cowra Council wish to advise that Dearnu Pty Ltd as contractor for Council will commence establishment of the site at George Campbell Bridge on Darbys Falls Road, Wednesday 23 March 2022. Piling will commence shortly after, followed by the demolition of the existing timber bridge and eventual replacement of George Campbell Bridge with a

reinforced concrete structure.

A side track will be in use around the site, and traffic lights will be in operation for the duration of the project. Works are expected to take approximately five months, weather permitting. The replacement of the George Campbell Bridge is funded by the Federal Government Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program and Bridge Renewal Program and the NSW Government Regional Roads REPAIR program.
