


Temporary Closure Intersection Walker St-William St

Council has been working on watermain replacement works in William Street (pictured) and will need to temporarily close the William Street end of Walker Street on Monday 29 November 2021 to complete the connection. Residents and motorists are advised that access to Walker Street will remain available from Hartley Street during this time.
