Darbys Falls Road Works

Water Disruption - Gooloogong

As part of the Water Main Replacement Works in Gooloogong, Council will be completing the change over from the existing to the new water main recently installed.

To enable these works, water supply will temporarily be unavailable for the township of Gooloogong on **Tuesday 31 May 2022 (between 8.30am to 4.00pm)** weather and resources permitting.

Residents are advised to draw off and store sufficient water for the period of interruption. Please do not to turn on any taps during the interruption, and when supply has been restored, run taps for two minutes until the water becomes clean and free of air.

Water Leak Detection and Reduction Program

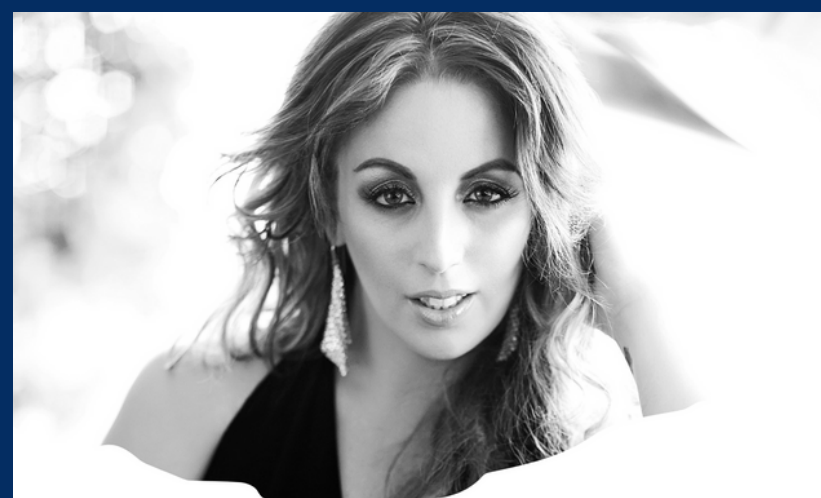
Council has received government funding to extend the water leak detection program to the villages of Koorawatha and Greenethorpe which is fantastic news.
