

### Chilean Needle Grass

Residents please be advised that Chilean Needle Grass is active and about to flower. This weed is listed as both a Weed of National Significance and under Regional Asset Protection in the Central Tablelands Strategic Weed Management Plan 2017-2022, and as such, land managers and occupiers are required to prevent spread from their land by implementing a suitable management plan. Any questions or sightings of this weed can be directed to Cowra Council's Biosecurity Officers.

### Heavy Patching Works

Heavy patching pavement improvements works are scheduled to commence Tuesday 9 November 2021 starting from the boundary of Limestone Creek - Mid Western Hwy (Sydney Road) working westbound toward Cowra. Works on Sydney Road are expected to take about four weeks, before moving on to Grenfell, Canowindra, Forbes and Boorowa Roads in the New Year. Locations will be updated weekly. Access to private residences and properties will not be affected by the work.

Residents and motorists are advised that there may be minor disruptions to traffic during this time. There will be traffic control in place and all temporary signage and traffic control measures should be followed. Council apologises for any inconvenience this may cause and appreciates your patience while this important work is carried out.
