Water Leak Detection and Reduction Program

Council is currently completing a leak detection and reduction program. The team from Central West Leak Detection and Plumbing are currently moving around the Cowra township area to identify any leaks in our water network. Investigations will take up to 8 weeks; during this time it is not anticipated that there will be any disruption to water supply.

The community can assist with leak reduction by continuing to report water mains breaks and leaking water meters. For more information or questions about leak detection, please call Council's Infrastructure & Operations Team on 6340 2070.

Pesticide notification - Bellevue Hill

Residents please be advised that Woody Weed control will be undertaken over the next three months at Bellevue Hill in the vicinity of the Lookout and the Scenic Drive exit road.

Priority weed trees will be controlled using Cut and Paint method to eliminate spray drift or residues that could have any adverse effect on surrounding native trees or the public. Starane Advanced mixed with carrier oil will be used to target woody weed species. Cut branches will be left in-situ until leaf fall has been completed, before removal from the site at a later date.
