

THE ALPHABET OF AWESOME SCIENCE



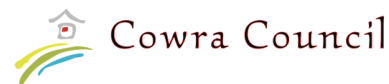

Works – Merriganowry Road, Billimari

Council and Contractors are undertaking investigation works beside Merriganowry Road, Billimari (approx. 600m west of the Balcombs Road intersection) for the Cowra Drought Water Security Project.

Investigation works commenced 5 April 2022 for a period up to 15 days. During this time, Merriganowry Road will be reduced to a single carriageway with both traffic lights and concrete barriers in place.

Residents and motorists are advised that there will be minor disruption to traffic conditions during this time. All temporary signage and traffic control measures must be followed whilst in place.
