### Sticky Nightshade

Landholders in the Cowra Shire LGA are advised that Sticky Nightshade (*Solanum sisymbriifolium*) is expanding rapidly throughout the Shire.

This weed is listed as a Priority Weed under the Central Tablelands Regional Weed Management Plan 2017-2022. Landholders, managers or occupiers of the land are to ensure that this plant is not bought, sold, grown, carried or released into the environment and are to reduce impacts from the plant on priority assets and mitigate spread from their land.

Targeted, ongoing inspections by Cowra Council's Biosecurity Officers will be occurring along all properties adjacent to the Belubula River in the Cowra LGA over the next four weeks under Part 8 Section 98 of the Biosecurity Act 2015.

If the weed is found, a Weed Control notice will be issued.

### Demolition of tennis court fencing and lighting at Harry Chapman Park

The fencing, lighting and tennis court area at Harry Chapman Park are in poor in condition with a large light fitting recently becoming dislodged in a storm.

Work will begin this week to remove the fencing, lighting and sections of concrete retaining walls by Cowra Council as the area has become unsafe.

There are currently no plans to replace the tennis courts at the site.

A new public amenities facility is under construction at the park.
