



LIQUID TRADE WASTE - BUSINESS APPROVALS

All liquid wastes discharged to the sewerage system, other than domestic sewage, are classified as trade waste and need to be approved under section 68 of the Local Government Act, 1993.

We understand that COVID-19 is having a significant impact on our business customers and in particular, food service customers. If you're closing your business during this time, please contact us so that we may assist you with your trade waste requirements. If you're continuing to trade at normal capacity, your requirements will stay the same.

If you are proposing a new business activity, and that activity generates liquid waste that is discharged to the sewerage system, then it is a legal requirement that you lodge a Liquid Trade Waste Application with Council. If liquid trade waste is produced but not discharged to the sewerage system, Council still need to be notified.

PUBLIC NOTICE - LEASE OF COWRA VISITORS CENTRE - CROWN RESERVE 190056

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 47 of the Local Government Act 1993, Cowra Shire Council is proposing to enter into a lease with Cowra Tourism Corporation for the Cowra Visitors Centre Crown Reserve 190056 at Cowra. The lease will be for a term of five years with a five year option. The Crown Reserve is located on the corner of Lachlan Valley Way & Grenfell Road, being Lots 408 and 409 DP 726962 Parish Mulyan, County Forbes.

The purpose of the Crown Reserve is 'Museum and Tourist Information Centre'. The lease for the Cowra Visitors Centre Crown Reserve 190056 will be in accordance with the adopted Plan of Management. All members of the public are invited to make a submission in relation to this proposal.

EXHIBITION OF DRAFT COWRA COUNCIL DEVELOPMENT CONTROL PLAN 2021

Pursuant to Clause 18 of the Environmental Planning & Assessment Regulation 2000, resolution of Cowra Council at its Ordinary Meeting held 26 July 2021, and the requirements of the Cowra Council Community Participation Plan 2020, the draft Cowra Shire Council Development Control Plan 2021 (draft DCP) is placed on exhibition for public comment from Friday 13 August 2021 to Friday 10 September 2021.

The draft DCP applies to all land that is located within the Cowra Shire Local Government Area and is intended to replace the Cowra Council Development Control Plan 2014. The purpose of the draft DCP is to give effect to the aims of Cowra Local Environmental Plan 2012 (the LEP), to facilitate development that is permissible under the LEP, and to provide guidance on achieving the objectives of land-use zones prescribed under the LEP.

At the Ordinary Meeting held 26 July 2021, Council also resolved to place a copy of Cowra Local Environmental Plan 2012 on public display (for information reference purposes only) in accordance with Clause 18(b) of the Environmental Planning & Assessment Regulation 2000.

The draft DCP and LEP may be viewed during normal business hours at Council's Customer Service Centre, 116 Kendal Street, Cowra NSW 2794. A copy of the draft DCP and LEP is also available via the Council's website www.cowracouncil.com.au. Hard copies may be purchased from Council on request (photocopying charges will apply).

All submissions must be made in writing to the General Manager, Cowra Shire Council, Private Bag 342 Cowra NSW 2794, or by email to council@cowra.nsw.gov.au. All submissions must be received by Council no later than 4.00pm on 10 September 2021. Please note that all submissions, including any personal information, will be made available in a public report.
