## Council Business approvals for liquid trade waste

## What is Liquid Trade Waste?

The definition of Trade Waste ensures that all liquid wastes discharged to the sewerage system, other than domestic sewage, are classified as trade waste and need to be approved under section 68 of the Local Government Act, 1993.

If you have an existing business, or you are proposing a new business activity, and that activity generates liquid waste that is discharged to the sewerage system, then it is a legal requirement that you lodge a Liquid Trade Waste Application with Council. If liquid trade waste is produced but not discharged to the sewerage system Council still need to be notified.
