# 2023 Recycled Art for Cowra Award (RAFCA) Sunday 17th September 2023

RAFCA is about creating art from recycled materials. This year's theme is:

## Dreaming: Stories and Legends

Individual and group entries are encouraged and entrants must use materials specific to their category. Entry costs and prizes are as follows:

Note: 2nd and 3rd prizes & Highly Commended certificates will be awarded at the discretion of the judges.

MATERIALS – all materials used must be recycled
Preschool & Infants: paper, cardboard, plastic, cans, fabric, wood
Primary: paper, cardboard, plastic, cans, fabric, wood and metal
High School: paper, cardboard, plastic, cans, fabric, wood, metal, glass and tyres
Note: small amounts of other materials may be used if needed in the junior categories eg. metal fasteners.
Noxious or hazardous materials are not permitted.

### **Terms of Entry**

- 1. Entry is open in the above categories for participants in 2023.
- 2.Entry forms must be correctly completed, signed and accompanied by the appropriate entry fee (either cash or cheque). A receipt is available if required. Information provided is for competition purposes only and cannot be accessed by any other person.
- 3.Entrants guarantee their work to be original and that they are the copyright owner of the work. Works may not have been exhibited in a previous RAFCA competition.
- 4.Entries will be accepted at the Nguluway Room on Thursday 14th between 12-5pm.
- If you need to deliver outside this time, please make prior arrangements with Philippa Childs at Council.
- 5. Transporting, erection, display and dismantling of sculptures are at the entrant's own risk. All measures will be taken to prevent damage to works, but no liability is held by the Tidy Towns Committee. All costs associated are the responsibility of the entrant.
- 6. Judging is on **Friday 15th September** by a panel of 3 judges appointed by the Tidy Towns Committee. Judges' decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into. Winners will be notified by phone/email following judging, and recipients are requested to be at the **Nguluway Room** on **Sunday 17th September at 1pm** to accept their awards. Cheques will be presented at a later date, usually at a school assembly.
- 7. Prizes may be awarded, at the discretion of the judges, for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Highly Commended.
- 8. There will be a Best in Show grand prize, awarded as a separate item, for the best overall entry.
- 9. The People's Choice award will be decided by the most votes submitted by viewers at a gold coin entry per vote. Money raised in this category will be donated to a local community group.
- 10. Entries not being exhibited at the Cowra Show must be collected between **1:30-3pm on Sunday 17 Septembe**r following the prize giving, or within the next 2 days by appointment, unless prior arrangements are made. Entries not collected within the specified times will become the property of the Tidy Towns Committee.
- 11. The Tidy Towns Committee may reproduce images of works submitted for archival, cataloguing and promotional purposes. All entrants permit the Committee the use of images for these purposes.

- Other materials sourced by entrants may be used in accordance with the conditions of entry.
