

Summary of decisions

December 2023 Council Meeting



- Council noted the bequest from the Estate of the late Margaret Edith Weir of \$50,000 to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery and \$50,000 to the Peace Bell Committee.
 - Council will send a letter to the family expressing appreciation for this most generous gesture.
 - Council asked that the Art Gallery Advisory Committee and the Peace Bell committee be requested to give consideration to how to best use the funds and make recommendations to Council.
 - Council to allocate an additional \$40,000, funded from the Built Asset Replacement Reserve, to allow for resources to be engaged to complete the full application for Aquatic Centre funding under the Federal Government's Growing Regions program.

 - Council committed \$1,500 to Woodstock Soldiers Memorial Hall to assist with Festival of Small Halls on 10 January 2024.

 - Council approved, in principle, the Class 3 special event, Australia Day, to be held by Cowra Shire Council on 26 January 2024, subject to compliance with the requirements of TfNSW and NSW Police.
