

Summary of decisions - July 2022 Council Meeting



- Council will place the Cowra Council Workforce Management Strategy on public exhibition for a period of 28 days.

- Council noted the Investments and Financial Report for June 2022.
 - Council donated \$700 to Neighbourhood Watch for the installation of replacement signs and 50% of the cost of bin charges to Gooloogong Log Cabin Hall Inc for the 2022 Esky Ball.
 - Council will maintain the RFS fleet assets in its financial reports. Council will write to the Auditor General – Audit Office of NSW, State Minister for Emergency Services, Leader of the NSW Opposition and Local Government NSW requesting that RFS fleet assets are transferred to the RFS as per Australian Accounting Standards (AASB 116, 7(a)).
