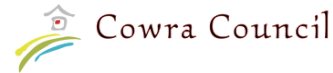

## Shared Pathway - Cowra Peace Precinct

Preparation to construct the Valley View section of shared pathway in the Cowra Peace Precinct is underway. You may notice council staff and contractors working along the path route over the coming months.

The route has been marked and mown onsite ready for earthworks to begin in June 2023. With site conditions permitting, a slip form machine will work along the route in July 2023 to pour, form and finish the new 2.5m wide concrete path.

The path route has been surveyed in accordance with the Cowra Peace Precinct Master Plan 2010 and approved Development Application for the Valley View Estate.
