

 works are being undertaken by Council. Once completed, Council will be moving
 across the LGA to undertake works on various state roads.

Employment Zones Reforms

The NSW Government has introduced changes to zonings across NSW including within Cowra's Business and Industrial precincts.

The changed employment zones were introduced into legislation on 16 December 2022 but will not commence until 26 April 2023. The following zones under the Cowra LEP 2012 have now been changed as a result of the planning reform.
