Council's annual grants program allows eligible community groups to apply and lodge their application by Tuesday 28 February 2023.


Applicants are able to apply for grants falling under five categories including building and facility development, arts and culture, small capital equipment, sport and recreation and new events.

The guidelines and criteria remain the same this round, with Council looking for community groups who are not-for-profit, primarily volunteer-run and based within the Cowra Shire with projects that directly benefit the local community.

#### Cowra Drought Water Security Project Billimari Pipeline

Local contractor, Thompson's Irrifab, will be commencing construction of the Billimari Pipeline (rural portion) in the coming days, weather permitting.

The rural portion of the pipeline runs from Jumbuck Lane, Billimari to the intersection of North Logan and Glen Logan Roads, Cowra being a total of 23km.

There will be minor traffic delays during construction of the Billimari Pipeline with traffic control onsite. Works are anticipated to continue until July 2023.

These works form part of the Cowra Drought Water Security Project which will provide Cowra with an alternative water supply source in the event of a severe drought. This Project has been funded via the NSW Government's Safe and Secure Program.

Landholders along the pipeline route will receive additional communications from Thompsons Irrifab as the project progresses. Council looks forward to working with Thompsons Irrifab to deliver this portion of the project.
