REVIVING COWRA'S TOURIST RAILWAY

Cowra Mayor, Cr. Bill West met with representatives from rail contractors Onrail Industries and Lachlan Valley Railway (LVR) volunteers at the Cowra Locomotive Depot this week to inspect works to reactivate the LVR's Cowra tourist railway.

These works are being supported with funding from Round 2 of the Australian Government's Drought Communities Program. The funding was allocated by Cowra Council to a number of community-based projects throughout the Shire that have been delivered over the last three years. This is the last local project to be completed under the program.

When finalised the LVR will be able to operate heritage tourist rail services from Cowra station to the eastern bank of the Lachlan River, near the Cowra Railway Bridge. The work is being completed by Onrail Industries, assisted by LVR volunteers.
