### Seniors Week 2026!

Cowra will come alive with colour, creativity and connection this March as the NSW Seniors Festival returns with a vibrant program of events for local seniors.

Running from Monday 2 Mar to Sunday 15 Mar 2026, the Cowra Seniors Festival will offer a diverse range of free and low-cost activities, celebrating this year's theme, 'Live life in colour' – encouraging seniors

to embrace creativity, community and an active lifestyle.

### Aquatic Centre Upgrade – Initial Works

In early March 2026, some minor early works will occur to assess ground conditions ahead of construction. These works are part of preparing the site for the new aquatic centre. A construction compound will also be established outside the Cowra Aquatic Centre during March. Importantly, the pool will remain open and fully operational for patrons until the end of March 2026, with major construction beginning in April 2026.

### Line Marking Safety On Our Roads

Council has recently resealed several streets across the town as part of our ongoing road maintenance program. After resealing, permanent line markings such as parking spaces, lane lines and pedestrian crossings are reinstated as soon as possible. In

the meantime, temporary markings are in place until Council's line-marking contractors complete the final works.

We ask all road users to please take extra care, be patient, and look out for one another especially around school zones until the permanent markings are finished.

### Scenic Drive – Temporary Stop/Go Traffic Control

Council wishes to advise the community that temporary traffic control (stop/go) will be in place on Monday 16 Feb 2026 (7.30am-5.00pm) on Scenic Drive (adjacent to the Cowra Water Treatment Plant). These traffic control measures are necessary whilst heavy plant is moving in and out of the Cowra Water Treatment Plant completing planned maintenance.
