FOOTPATH TRADING PERMIT

- FOOTPATH TRADING PERMITS - WHAT HAS CHANGED**
Previously, all businesses paid an application fee of \$330.00, Annual Renewal Fee of \$71.00, Inspection Fee of \$2,000.00. These fees have been waived until 1 January 2027.
- WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR MY BUSINESS?**
Businesses will be able to lodge Footpath Trading Applications, together with the required Public Liability Insurance cover at no charge until 1 January 2027. Existing Footpath Trading Permit holders will not need to pay inspection or renewal fees until 1 January 2027.
- WHAT CAN I PLACE ON THE FOOTPATH, ONCE I HAVE A PERMIT?**
Business owners can lodge applications for outdoor dining, signage, teardrop flags and flowerpots. Once you have an approval in place you can undertake these activities within the Footpath area.
- WHAT HAPPENS ONCE I HAVE AN APPROVAL?**
Once you have your approval and appropriate public liability insurances in place you can commence utilising the space along the footpath as approved.
