Road works

On Tuesday 19 May 2026, Council plans to commence refurbishment of the shoulder on the eastern side of Rileys Road, between Merriganowry and North Logan Roads.

To facilitate the work there will be a temporary road closure during working hours, with a detour in place via Sloane Street, Billimari for through traffic.

Local residents on Rileys Road will continue to have access during works.

Works are expected to take approximately 1 week, weather permitting.

Proposal to licence public land

In accordance with section 46 of the 'Local Government Act 1993', Cowra Shire Council as the Crown Land Manager for Squire Park Reserve 70763, intends at the expiration of 28 days after publication of the notice, to grant a licence for the following property ('Land'): Squire Park Rest Centre, part of Lot 17 18 19 20 Section 17 DP 758300, Squire Park, Kendal Street Cowra, which is part of Squire Park Crown Reserve 70763.

Proposed licence

The intention is to grant a licence for the purpose of the Squire Park Rest Centre which offers a valuable community resource by providing baby change rooms and nursing facilities, showers, female toilets and an accessible toilet. The Rest Centre provides the community an opportunity to purchase light meals and refreshments in the Café, which is open and staffed for nominated hours.

Term: For a period up to three (3)

years including options Under the proposed 3 year term of the licence, the subject land will continue to be used as a Rest Centre in accordance with the Plan of Management.

Commencement Date: 1 July 2027
