Council advises that the car park adjacent to the Cowra Aquatic Centre will be temporarily closed to allow demolition of the former filtration room. Tuesday 21 April to Thursday 23 April 2026 – During work hours only.

The closure is required to allow heavy vehicles to safely access the site. The area will be traffic-controlled for the duration of the works.

School bus drop-off and pick-up for Red Bend Catholic College will continue as normal and will not be impacted.

Alternative public parking will be available via Taragala Street and

Carobean Avenue.
